## **NOTICE OF ADOPTION PROPOSED AREA-WIDE NATURAL HERITAGE SYSTEM STRATEGY FOR THE DISTRICT OF MANITOULIN**

In accordance with Section 17(23) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, this notice shall provide "Notice of Adoption" in respect of the proposed Official Plan Amendment (OPA), No. A-3, including a draft Natural Heritage System Strategy (NHSS) for the District of Manitoulin, adopted by the Manitoulin Planning Board on January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023.

The Provincial Policy Statement (PPS) 2020 defines what a Natural Heritage System is. Under the 2020 PPS, Natural Heritage Systems must be identified in Ecoregions 6E and 7E. The Manitoulin Planning Area is located within region 6E.

The Official Plan for the District of Manitoulin is a legal document that contains the goals, objectives and policies to manage and direct land-use changes and their effects on the cultural, social, economic and natural environment within the planning area. The current Official Plan, as amended, was approved by the Ontario Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing (MMAH) on October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

The Ontario Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing (MMAH), by Modification No. 21 to the Official Plan requires that:

*' within three years after the approval of the Official Plan, the Manitoulin Planning Board shall prepare an Area-Wide Natural Heritage System Strategy.'*
